YOUR WAY TO ESSEN

International Airports & High-Speed Train System

From Frankfurt:

Take the ICE high-speed train from Frankfurt Airport Station to Essen Main Station (approx. 2–2.5 hours, usually with a change in Düsseldorf or Duisburg).

From Düsseldorf:

Take the train from Düsseldorf Airport Station to Essen Main Station (approx. 25–30 minutes, direct connection).

From Cologne:

Take the train from Cologne/Bonn Airport to Essen Main Station (approx. 1–1.5 hours, usually via Düsseldorf or Duisburg).

From Essen:

Main Station, take subway line U17 (direction Karlsplatz) to station Universitätsklinikum Essen (approx. 10 minutes) or take a taxi (approx. 10 minutes).

By car.

From Frankfurt Airport:

Take the A3 motorway towards Cologne, then change at Breitscheid junction to the A52 towards Essen (approx. 2.5–3 hours).

From Düsseldorf Airport:

Take the A52 motorway towards Essen (approx. 30 minutes, 30 km).

From Cologne Airport:

Take the A3 towards Oberhausen, then at Breitscheid junction change to the A52 towards Essen (approx. 1–1.5 hours, 80 km).
